




Essentials of Psychiatric Diagnosis: Responding to the Challenge of DSM-5 (Hardback)

An index of common presenting symptoms lists possible diagnoses that must be considered for each. The Appendix (which can also be accessed at the companion website) features a Crosswalk to ICD-10-CM codes plus links to coding resources.
